






### ANNUAL CRUDE OIL PRODUCTION 2010-2016











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#### TOTAL ANNUAL PETROLEUM RECEIPTS (2011 – 2016)



### **KEY CONCERNS**

 Petroleum Revenues have been used to tackle too many national problems at the same time

- This has weakened the potential impacts of oil revenues on the social economic development of Ghana
- Only 11% of petroleum revenue has been allocated to the agriculture sector, which is the mainstay of the economy

### **WAY FORWARD**

- PIAC has made these concerns known to the government through its annual and semi-annual reports
- PIAC believes there ought to be properly defined guidelines on the selection of the priority areas
- PIAC believes that few LEGACY projects should be identified and supported by the ABFA
